REMINDER: County to Host Parks & Recreation Public Input Meetings on Monday, 11/18 & Tuesday, 11/19

Troup County, Ga. November 15, 2019 – Troup County is hosting two Public Input Meetings to collect feedback that will be used in creating a new Parks and Recreation Master Plan. The County would like to invite the community to attend in order to contribute feedback, ideas, and preferences regarding the future of Parks and Recreation.

The meetings will be held in Hogansville and West Point in order to incorporate residents from the north end as well as the south end, but there will also be a survey option available to contribute input at a later date. The Public Input Meetings are scheduled as follows:

WHAT: 1st Troup County Public Meeting - West Point

WHEN: Monday, November 18th from 5:30PM to 6:30PM

WHERE: Virginia Cook Activity Center, 806 Martin Luther King Drive, West Point, GA 31833

WHAT: 2nd Troup County Public Meeting – Hogansville

WHEN: Tuesday, November 19th from 5:30PM to 6:30PM

WHERE: Hogansville Public Library, 310 Johnson Street, Hogansville, GA 30230

The meetings will provide the opportunity to engage our communities across Troup County. Comments will be recorded at the meetings and provided to the consulting firm to complete the master plan. The community input will be instrumental to the future of parks and recreation as we move forward with the master plan process.

The Troup County Board of Commissioners approved the contract to create a new Parks and Recreation Master Plan in August 2019, which will be funded through SPLOST V funds. The consultants will create a plan based on both community input and industry best practices to improve the overall recreational amenities offered in Troup County. The master plan will be used as a framework to assess expected growth and development while providing goals and objectives for future recreation services.
