## Personal Property Returns: PT-50P, PT-50M & PT-50A

Due to the COVID-19 crisis in our country, The Troup County Board of Assessors will receive returns via email as timely filed:

Only if, the email filings are received on or before April 1<sup>st</sup> and the \*hard copy is postmarked no later than 10 days following the deadline of April 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. The last day for mailing the \*hard copy will be April 11<sup>th</sup>.

Please mail original hard copy with wet signature.

Please remember to mail the returns before April 11th.

## \*Freeport Application: PT-50PF

Taxpayers must file Freeport Exemption Applications by <u>April 1st</u> to be eligible to receive the full exemption. Applications filed after April 1 can receive a partial exemption up to June 1.
