Under general direction performs personal property audits, making necessary adjustments, including sending out audit notices, reviewing documentation, and performing on-site inspections; reviews exemption requests and makes recommendations to the Board of Assessors; presents appeal cases at Board of Equalization hearings or in court. This position is under the supervision of the Chief Appraiser.

The qualified candidate will have:

- ⇒ Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in Accounting or course of study closely related to the occupational field and one year related work experience, including supervisory experience, or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience
Must be at least 21 years of age
- ⇒ Knowledge of appraisal methods including selection and computation of the appropriate factors influencing the value of personal property
- ⇒ Knowledge of the geography of Troup County
- ⇒ Knowledge of state and county laws, rules, and regulations regarding personal property tax and appraisal methods
- ⇒ Proficient with Microsoft office system to include Word and Excel and in the use of typewriter, printer, calculator, and knowledge of WinGap Appraisal Software
Must possess or be able to obtain an Appraiser III designation from the Georgia Department of Revenue.
Must maintain Appraiser III designation by successful completion of 40 hours DPR approved training bi-annually
- ⇒ Current, valid driver's license; driving record free of disqualifying traffic violations as set forth in County guidelines
- ⇒ Excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following:

- ⇒ Accurately value all personal property in Troup County
- ⇒ Responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Personal Property Department
Compiles an annual Personal Property Digest
- ⇒ On-site inspections and verification of valid accounts
Prepare and mail reporting forms and assessment notices
- ⇒ Review tax calculations of personal property reporting forms or returns
- ⇒ Coordinates and provides information and answers on valuation and tax related personal property questions
Prepare and check the mobile home digest
- ⇒ Performs all other related duties as assigned
