Under general supervision drives truck equipped with tandem dump body to transport loose materials, such as sand, gravel, crushed rock, coal, or other paving materials to job site.

The qualified candidate will have:

- ⇒ High school diploma or GED and a minimum of 3 months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combinations of education and experience
- ⇒ Must be at least 18 years of age
- ⇒ Current, valid CDL
- ⇒ Driving record must be free of disqualifying traffic violations as set forth in County guidelines
- ⇒ Skill in written, verbal, and interpersonal communication
- ⇒ Skill in operating equipment, such as dump truck and front end loader, and knowledge of how to service truck and other equipment
- ⇒ Skill in operating chain saw and in using hand tools, such as shovel, loop, rake, sling-blade, and bush ax
- ⇒ Must be able to successfully complete flagger certification training after employment

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following:

- ⇒ Operates a tandem dump truck to haul dirt and materials to job site
- ⇒ Performs a variety of labor intensive tasks when not operating the dump truck, to include shoveling gravel to repair driveways, cleaning debris from ditches and pipes, clearing leaves and limbs from right-of-way with sling-blade or bush ax, cutting trees from right-of-way with chain saw, loop asphalt
- ⇒ Performs road maintenance duties such as cutting holes and patching with asphalt
- ⇒ Performs all other related duties as assigned

Supervisor assigns work in terms of general instructions with many aspects covered specifically; however, the use of some judgment is required.
